of Blount of the <sup>TENNESSEE</sup> Tennessee do for the consideration of the  
sum to me in hand paid by Robithey Every of one hundred  
dollars & the said Peter Avery do hereon sell and for ever quit claim unto the  
said Robithey Every and to her heirs and assigns for ever my lands and  
improvements houses and out houses with all my right of occupancy thereof  
belonging with all my horses my horned cattle and with my household furniture  
likewise my farming tools and hogs and I the said Peter Avery do for my self  
and my heirs marriage and will forever defend the afore said lands and Tennessee  
household furniture to Robithey Every and to her heirs and assigns for ever inter  
lined when wrote and before signed and sealed) Whereunto I have set my hand  
and placed my seal this 17 day of January 1798
