East Canton Ohio, July 31, 1925.

My Dear granddaughters,

I received thy very welcome letter yesterday, I was so glad to hear from thee and home, and home people.

I was sorry that, John Paul Seittel had passed away. He will surely be very much missed, and he certainly has been a very busy man, Thompson thought he was an older man than the paper gives him to be. — My father's parents names were Elijah and Susanna Hanson Grandmother Hanson's maiden name was Soriana she was a half sister of uncle Jesse Dawson. Fessie was Leahley Dawson's father and when she came to Ohio from North Carolina uncle Jesse came with her — In writing her <sup>grand</sup> and father

2 names I would write them Elijah  
Hanson and Susanna Hanson. Elijah  
Hanson was born in 1797, and died in  
1876 - and my father was born and  
my grandfather was a soldier in the Re-  
volutionary war, and was discharged and was  
in a few months after my father was  
born in North Carolina. My grandmother  
Susanna was a widow when she came to  
Ohio and brought her children. Grand-  
father was buried in North Carolina. -  
My father was about 8 years old when  
he came to Ohio I have heard him say.  
and my grand mother was about 5 years  
old, she came from Georgia. My mother's  
name was Eliza Stubbs Daughter of Joseph  
and Zilpha Stubbs. My parents names  
were Elijah Hanson and <sup>Eliza</sup> Hanson (Stubbs)  
My father and mother both died in Ohio

3 In the list of thy brothers & sisters  
my brother Robert's wife's name was  
Prudence McKibbin. It is just a mistake  
that her name is not there Brother Joseph  
married Lydia Hicks Daughter of James  
and Betsey Betsey Hicks she lived only  
6 or 7 months and died of consumption  
she was a sister of brother Williams's wife  
She says there were 22 children. I knew  
that there were a big lot of them.  
Yes a big number of them. There nor I will  
neither one of us see them all in this  
world, some of the children were as old as I -  
How is thee getting along with getting them  
copied. I wish I was with thee to help thee  
do thy work. Have you got any of it down in  
the hills, or did I leave a bill with you & did  
you keep it. I dont know all the exact dates  
of births. I dont think it is any difference  
to a day the year in which they were born.  
Thee ask me just anything thee think of

and I will tell thee if I know, I know about  
the year when each one was born but not the  
day of all. I am a good deal forgetful, dont  
remember — I am glad you are getting along  
& well with the work, & hope in time you will  
get it all done. I am so glad that your stuff  
is growing good. It was so kind of thee to send  
the account of J. P. Battell I remember him. Would  
thee like to have the slip returned by so I will  
send it to thee, Was he living when thy father was  
down at Estherville awhile back. I am glad thy  
father went and saw the people. I am glad that  
thy grandmother is rather better fashion. I wish she  
could get well, and Mama too. I dont know how  
thy mother does keep up as well as she does, and  
thy father keeps along and thee too. I do hope that  
the boys are doing so well, and I hope that you  
will all be ready for school when it commences;  
Please dont any of you work too hard and I  
hope you will have plenty of fruit. Write again  
soon, I am so glad to get letters from any of you  
Love to each one of you from grandmother Dyle Blanton

hear from you all. I would be  
very glad to hear that you were  
all well. I am so sorry for thy  
mother and grandmother, It  
does seem very queer they dont  
get well. Can grandmother get about  
on crutches, or does she just lie  
in bed, and thy mother gets  
around and does a lot of work.  
- She must get very tired. I am  
so sorry for her. And does thy  
father have such headache as  
he did - I wish he would get.

well, and has good health  
, and does Merin keep so he  
get about, and William has  
the toothache that dont feel good  
any time, and how is Edith: I  
wish thee was well all the time,  
but I know thee is not— Well  
to get to thy Copying thee wanted  
some information about, I am  
glad thee is wanting to copy it,  
and I wish I could give it to thee  
as thee would like to have it,  
I had all my brothers and sisters  
births and deaths written down  
some weeks ago, and had thought  
of you children thought I would  
like you to have them, and I  
can give my fathers & Mothers birth  
and deaths, father was born in  
1797 and Mother in just 1800  
a few days. if I was going to write  
it down in the book, which I hope

thee will. I would give my  
fathers and mothers names  
and ages, Births and deaths first  
and then copy their childrens  
names ages births and deaths  
similar to the way we put it  
down in our bible. - Now thee  
put it down just the way thee  
wants to, and I will be satisfied.  
I really want thee to do just as  
thee pleases. It may be thy father  
has fathers and mothers down  
in the bible and I expect if he  
has he has it correct, mine  
may be a little trusted. Father  
was born in North ~~Car~~ Carolina,  
Mother, in Georgia Write and  
ask me any question thee is  
wanting to. I will gladly tell thee  
all I know, I will write thee  
again in a short time Keep

letters and hunt out of them  
what they find of use to to them,  
and I will send thee more as  
I feel like writing to thee

I will send a copy of my  
brothers and sisters. And thee and  
thy father & mother can look  
them over, and I will get some  
more looked over. I expect that thee  
can find something in the Bible  
about them, maybe thee may  
work away at them any how.  
I expect what thee gets from  
Calie and I will answer thee.

Thee paper noted some storm  
in Minnesota yesterday. I hope it  
did not hurt you badly.

I hope you are all well and  
getting along all. I love you  
all as ever thy grandmother  
Delora H. B. Stanton. Write to me  
any of you. I love you all
