Then 2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Abigail Avery the sum of three hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States of America to be paid to her in six months after my Decease together with one good cow and six good Sheep, and also all the cloth bedclothes and wearing apparel which shee shall manufacture during my lifetime and shall be remaining at my Decease, but if at my Decease my wife aforesaid shall claim her right of Dower and will not relinquish the same, and relinquish her claim in a certain obligation and agreement made between her and myself before we were married wherein it was specified that she should receive the sum of five hundred Dollars at my Decease, then it not my intention that should have the three hundred Dollars, the cow and sheep and other articles bequeathed above - 3^d all the remainder of my real and personal Estate of what nature or kind soever I give devise, and bequeath the same to my beloved children in fee simple whose names I have inserted - *viz* William Avery, Blisha Avery, Stephen Avery, Mary Chapman wife of David Chapman, (Deceased) Wheelhamah Sniffin wife of Nathaniel Sniffin (Deceased) Suranna Williams wife of John Williams, Sarah Peatt wife of Henry Peatt, Nancy Mead wife of Enos Mead, Doreny Avery Daughter of Abigail Avery my present wife, and if my said wife Abigail shall have a my more children while we live together or shall be like for one at my decease by me, to them and those whose names I have mentioned above, I give devise and bequeath in fee simple all my real and personal Estate as aforesaid, to be equally divided between them - and 4th I further nominate and appoint Isaac Simpkins of Poundridge and Thomas Smith of South Salem both of Westchester County and State aforesaid Executors of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all other and former wills by me made.
